B. HEALTH DEPARTMENT - Teresa Fisher

1. Consider approval for the Shawnee County Health Department (SCHD) to apply for the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) Regional Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Aid-to-Local grant for State Fiscal Year 2026 (SFY26).

C. PUBLIC WORKS - Curt Niehaus

1. Consider awarding the bid letting to Bettis Asphalt & Construction Co., Inc. of Topeka for a road improvement project on NW 46th between Fielding and Rochester Roads at a cost of \$10,215,740.40, and authorization and execution of construction **Contract C79-2025** with the same entity. The construction will be paid for using the 2017-2031 1/2-cent Retailers' Sales Tax program.
