A. COUNTY CLERK – Lisa Schmitt

1. Consider all voucher payments.
2. Consider correction orders.

B. PUBLIC WORKS - Curt Niehaus

1. Consider authorization and execution of **Contract C172-2025** with Motorola Solutions for the purchase of 30 budget-approved communications radios, with accessories and spare batteries, at a total cost of \$78,536.75. Funding will come from the 2025 Public Works Operating Budget.
2. Consider a request to exchange \$670,935.63 in 2025 federal fiscal year funds for \$603,842.07 in state transportation funds under the Federal-Aid Fund Exchange Master Agreement.
3. Consider a request to lease four Superior Brooms from Berry Tractor of Wichita, KS via a three-year lease agreement (**Contract C173-2025**) with First Bank of Sterling, KS.

C. SOLID WASTE - Bill Sutton
