 - A. Consider acceptance of a permanent right-of-way easement relating to a bridge replacement project on NW 78th Street over Halfday Creek, and authorization to pay the agreed settlement amount of \$915.00. - 1. Consider approval of **Contract C2026156** with Waldinger Corporation to provide one year of maintenance for HVAC controls within the adult detention center, at a cost of \$6,252.00 to be paid from the FY2026 detention budget.
- 2. Request approval of the FY27 Behavioral Health Services Funding grant application Contract C2026 under HB2021 to the Department of Corrections for the Juvenile Detention Center in the amount of \$356,608.20.
- 3. Consider approval of **Contract C2026157** with Astra Mental Health and Recovery and the Juvenile Detention Center to provide behavioral health and substance-use consultations, assessments and treatment services to the juvenile population. Funded through State Grant Funds.

4. Consider approval of **Contract C2026158** with CKF Addiction Treatment Center Inc. (CKF) and the Juvenile Detention Center to provide a peer mentor on-site to provide substance-use disorder programming. Funded through State Grant Funds.
