- A. Shawnee County Bridge (OSN-206) replacement project S-121056.00, KDOT project 89 C- 5147-01: Consider approval of **Contract C214-2022** (Supplemental Agreement No.1) to Contract C464-2021 (KDOT agreement 422-21 approved 12-9-21), which amends the original agreement by capping the "Secretary's funding limit" (80% of the combined participating costs of Construction and CE) to \$1,000,000.00 — Public Works.
- B. Acknowledge receipt of correspondence from Sheriff Hill regarding the renewal of an annual subscription with LEFTA Systems to provide IT support along with updates and technical support calls at an annual cost of \$1,891.08.
- C. Acknowledge receipt of correspondence from Sheriff Hill regarding the renewal of a subscription to Watch Systems for the Offender Watch Services which provides notifications, address verifications, reminders and mobile apps at a yearly cost of \$8,443.36.

B. PARKS + RECREATION - Tim L. Laurent

- 1. Consider approval to award bid #029-22 and negotiate a contract with RailWorks Track Services, LLC for repairs and improvements of the Gage Park Mini-Train tracks, ties and culverts utilizing \$128,900.00 plus any additional unit costs negotiated for the project as funding is provided from Building Maintenance (3R) Fund.

C. PUBLIC WORKS – Curt Niehaus

1. Consider approval to issue "Requests for Qualifications" for engineering design services for a road improvement project on NW 46th Street from the west intersection with Button Road to the roundabout at Rochester Road, a distance of approximately 1.9 miles. This project is the first of two SN Co. road projects which are 100% funded via the 2017-2031 countywide sales tax program.
2. Consider approval of a request to award bid to King Construction Co. of Hesston, KS for an emergency bridge replacement project (SW 61st Street over Six-Mile Creek) at a cost of \$863,801.70, and authorization and execution of **Contract C216-2022** for same. Funding will come from the "County Bridges" portion of the 2017-2031 countywide 1/2 cent sales tax program.

D. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS - Brian Cole

1. Consider authorization and execution of **Contract C215-2022**, a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Topeka, to allocate \$28,714.00 of the 2022 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant funds to Shawnee County for the purchase of replacement tasers at an estimated cost of \$40,320.00, with the balance to be paid from the agency's operational budget.
2. Request approval to negotiate final agreement with Armor Health for medical and mental health services for department inmates and clients, to begin on January 1, 2023.
