- B. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS - Brian Cole
 - 1. Consider the authorization and execution of **Contract C253-2022** with Alpha Media to provide recruitment plans for the Health Department and the Department of Corrections from September 1st through November 30th at a cost of \$14,805.00 (Health Dept) and \$20,040.00 (Dept of Corrections), with funding to be paid through each department's budgets.

C. PUBLIC WORKS - Curt Niehaus

1. Consider awarding bid to Bettis Asphalt & Construction Co., Inc. of Topeka, KS, for a pavement cold mill & overlay project (SW 57th from Topeka City Limits to South Topeka Boulevard) at a cost of \$99,221.13, and authorization and execution of **Contract C254-2022** for same. The project will be funded using the 2022 Public Works Operating Budget.

D. PARKS + RECREATION - Tim L. Laurent

1. Consider authorization and execution of **Contract C255-2022** with RailWorks Track Services, LLC for repairs to the Gage Park Mini-Train tracks including ties and culverts. Funds in the amount of \$128,900.00 plus any additional unit costs necessary for the project are provided by the Building Maintenance (3R) Fund.
2. Consider authorization and execution of **Contract C256-2022** with JP Construction for the renovation of the men's restroom at the Envista Softball Complex utilizing \$115,825.00 from the Building Maintenance (3R) Fund.
3. Consider authorization and execution of **Contract C257-2022** with the Greater Topeka Rowing Development Association to set out the conditions for a fall regatta at Lake Shawnee. Expenses are offset by special event fees totaling \$700.00 to be deposited into the Building Maintenance Fund.
