Acknowledgment of KDOT Transportation Alternatives Program Grant in the amount of \$696,296.00 for the new Deer Creek Trail Robinson Extension at an estimated cost of \$946,055.21 and approval on KDOT Form 1032 requested by Parks + Recreation pertaining to the grant. The Shawnee County Park + Recreation's estimated cost for the trail is \$249,759.00 to be paid from the Parks + Recreation building fund.
2.
